Dorrance Scholarship

- Eligibility: Seniors who are 1st generation to attend college (neither parent/stepparent holds a 4 year degree), minimum GPA of a 3.0, SAT score of 1110 or higher or ACT score of 22 or higher, demonstrated financial need, plan to attend one of Arizona's three in state universities
- Amount: \$12,000 per year with international study/travel opportunities
